

# WHAT WE DO

## 1. NFF ANNUAL AWARDS DINNER

- a. More than 1,600 of the game's most influential supporters gather each year in New York City to honor those who embody the spirit of the game.
- b. Along with the recognition of the National Scholar-Athlete Class and the induction of the College Football Hall of Fame Class, numerous other awards are given to dynamic business, military and community leaders.

## 2. COLLEGE FOOTBALL HALL OF FAME

- a. Annually induct the greatest coaches and players into the Hall of Fame in Atlanta, Ga.
- b. Screening process includes use of District Screening Committees, member vote and Honors Court consideration

## 3. SCHOLAR-ATHLETE PROGRAM

- a. Distribute approximately \$1.3 million annually for high school and college players to continue their education
- b. National Scholar-Athlete Awards, presented by Fidelity Investments
  - i. Annually award an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship to 12-15 intercollegiate football players from all divisions based on a player's academic and athletic accomplishments
- c. William V. Campbell Trophy, presented by Fidelity Investments and showcased inside its official home at the New York Athletic Club
  - i. Recognize one individual out of the National Scholar-Athlete Class as the absolute best in the country for his academic success, football performance and exemplary community leadership; the recipient's postgraduate scholarship increases to \$25,000.
- d. Hampshire Honor Society
  - i. Honors the college football players from all divisions of play who each maintain a 3.2 GPA or better to highlight football's unique ability to develop tomorrow's brightest leaders

#### 4. NFF CHAPTER NETWORK

- a. National High School Scholar-Athletes
  - Selected from 500,000 high school football players, one player from each of the five regions of the NFF Chapter Network is honored for their combined academic and athletic excellence at the Chapter Awards Luncheon held in conjunction with the Annual Awards Dinner.
- b. NFF Chapter Network Scholar-Athletes
  - i. Nationwide network of 12,000 members and 120 chapters that stage more than 1,000 events
  - ii. Individual scholar-athlete awards distributed at each event
- c. High School Showcases (Houston, TX; Los Angeles, CA)
  - i. Annually provides more than 1,000 disadvantaged high school players an opportunity at no cost to showcase their skills and earn participation and academic scholarships at more than 100 divisional colleges (NCAA Division II, III and NAIA).

3. Outstanding Contribution to Amateur Football (OCAF)

Provides national recognition to an individual or organization whose efforts and activities in support of the Foundation and its goals has been local in nature. It also applies to individuals who have made significant contributions to the game of football, either to the manner in which it is played and coached or to the manner in which it is enjoyed by spectators.

## 4. John L. Toner Award

Presented annually to an Athletics Director who has demonstrated superior administrative abilities and shown outstanding dedication to college athletics and, particularly, college football.

- 5. Outstanding Football Official Award
  Honors a collegiate football official who has shown superior abilities in
  officiating and has demonstrated sportsmanship, integrity and character in
  collegiate athletics and amateur football.
- 6. Chris Schenkel Award
  Recognizes individuals who have had long, distinguished careers broadcasting college football with direct ties to a specific university
- 7. Legacy Award
  Honors individuals and organizations who have made extraordinary contributions to the NFF and/or embody its mission.

#### b. MacArthur Bowl

Presented to every national champion since 1959, representing the pinnacle of team achievement in college sports.

- c. Divisional National Championship Trophies

  National championship trophies presented to FCS, Division II, Division III and NAIA
  national champions at the annual AFCA Convention.
- d. National Hall of Fame Salute at the Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl
  As the culmination of the College Football Hall of Fame experience, the NFF showcases the recently inducted class during the game.
- e. On-Campus Salutes, presented by Fidelity Investments
  In conjunction with the schools they played at, each Hall of Famer is honored in front of their home crowds with a plaque that will remain on permanent display at the school.
- f. Faculty Salutes, presented by Fidelity Investments
  The NFF salutes the critical role of the faculty athletics representatives from each of the schools represented in the National Scholar-Athlete class.
- g. NFF Leadership Hall of Fame Induct the nation's most influential citizens into the NFF Leadership Hall of Fame.
